Some of our current practices include:

ENERGY

Low energy light bulbs have been installed where possible
Light sensors in all guest rooms with timers to control lights
Central heating by room blocks so heating can be switched off when bedrooms are not in use
Keycard control system installed in every room to control heating, lighting and air-conditioning
Energy saving lights on car park
We source energy efficient products whenever we upgrade or refurbish
Biomass boiler
Rapid charging points for electric vehicle

WATER

Dual flush toilets helping guests to save water
Guests are encouraged to reuse towels and linen
All rooms have showers as well as baths to encourage water saving
Conference water is filtered on site in glass bottles
Golf course machinery washing station which uses an industry leading Water Recycling System

TRANSPORT

Keep transport to a minimum by providing bike shed and footpath from bus stop
Regularly service vehicles to maintain their efficiency
Electric golf buggies

RECYCLING / WASTE

Recycling printer cartridges to the local school
Recycling our glass & cardboard waste
Reusing our glass water bottles for all conference facilities
Recycle metal tins from our kitchens
All of our kitchen oil is collected for recycling
